Holy month of Ramadan - March 2024

As I am sure most of you are aware, the holy month of Ramadan is due to commence on 10th/11th March subject to the moon sighting.

Ramadan is the ninth month in the Islamic calendar and is a period of prayer, self-control, charity and goodwill to others. Part of Ramadan is fasting, which is one of the Five Pillars (fundamental religious duties) of Islam. Muslims believe Ramadan and fasting has many benefits, such as feeling closer to Allah (God), developing better habits/character, increased charity, understanding of self and establishing better relationships with others.

We understand that the combination of fasting, as well as on-going school commitments including assessments, are a challenge for our Muslim students. Attendance to school during this period is as important as at any other time of the year. We respectfully ask you to support us and your child/ren to make sure that they continue to honour their educational responsibilities such as attending every day and attending all lessons on time every day during Ramadan.
