Multi-faith quiet room

To support spiritual, moral, social and cultural (SMSC) engagement in school, we are able to provide a supervised, quiet space to allow students to pray / reflect during their lunchtime.

Students should ensure that they have their lunch before using this facility as lunch will not be served in the last 5-minutes. Food should be eaten in the canteen or canopy areas as no food is allowed on the corridors or the classrooms. Under no circumstances will students be allowed to leave lessons to pray as there is no need for this to happen based on prayer times checked locally.
