Dear Parents/Carers

I hope you and your family are keeping safe and well during these unusual times. I am writing to you about the arrangements for GCSE Results Day. Given the current unprecedented situation, and to ensure the safety and well-being of students and their families, we have decided that Results Day this year will be conducted remotely. This will mean that students will receive their results via their school email on Thursday the 20th of August. The results will also be posted to their home address on this date, so will not arrive before Friday 21st August. **Students will need to know their school email log in details to access their results.** If students have forgotten their log in details they will need to email reception@beckfootupperheaton.org and a member of our IT team will get in touch.

The results email will be sent out as close to 9am as possible.

To support students fully, a member of staff will contact them via telephone on Results Day, to discuss their next steps.

If you have concerns about the grades you have been awarded, please consult the guidance on the school website which will be available on results day.

We know this is an unprecedented situation and is not the way we would choose to celebrate results day with our Year 11 students; however, we also recognise that the safety of everyone must be the primary concern.
