If you have already booked your appointments on School Cloud, these will be converted into video appointments for you, you do not need to book them again.

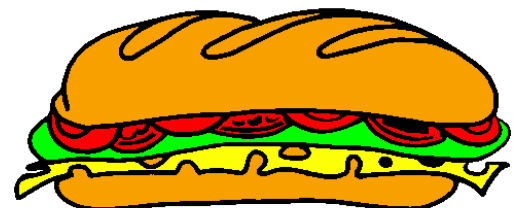
Each appointment will last for 5 minutes with your chosen teachers.

Year 11 will learn about future pathways and life skills. The week will kick off with interviews for every pupil in Year 11, followed by this CEIAG event on the Friday.

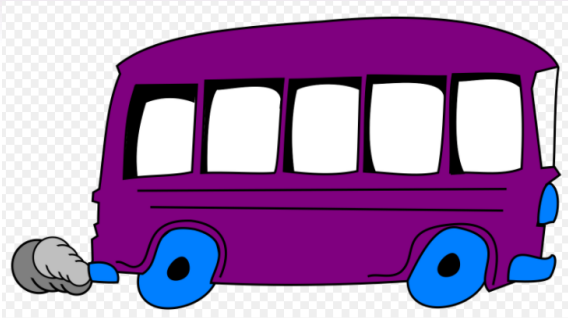
