MESSAGE TO FAMILIES

We continue to reiterate with students the need to keep themselves and our community safe and always conduct themselves respectfully.

We recognise that some of our students have had an unsettled eighteen months due to lock downs and the pandemic. However, we are now back fully in school and as such are working hard to re- affirm strong and supportive boundaries for our students that support their learning and help them to succeed. Unfortunately, there are a minority of young people who think it is acceptable to:

- Bring issues from outside into school (in the form of fights or arguments)
- Challenge adult authority by pushing past staff, being rude to staff or refusing to follow instructions.
- Disrupt the learning of others by arriving late to lessons or disrupting lesson flow by talking, shouting or ignoring instructions.
- Being abusive to other students via racist, sexist or unpleasant remarks.

We thank parents for their full support and ask you to continue to set clear boundaries for your children, supporting us to not accept “back chat”, defiance, unpleasantness to others or disruption of others learning.

Students are again having clear expectations communicated to them through this and next week’s assemblies and we’d ask you ensure your child understands the need to comply at all times.

The following are the key expectations that we have communicated:

- All students must wear masks on corridors and in communal spaces.
- All students will be expected to line up outside at the end of break and lunch to allow for orderly entrance into school.
- Lunch time sittings will be introduced from next week. Students can purchase food or eat their packed lunch in their allocated time. Students must sit down to eat and are then required to exit the dining area and go outside to allow for the next sitting.
- All students need to be always wearing full school uniform and this includes a coat appropriate for cold weather/ extended outside time.

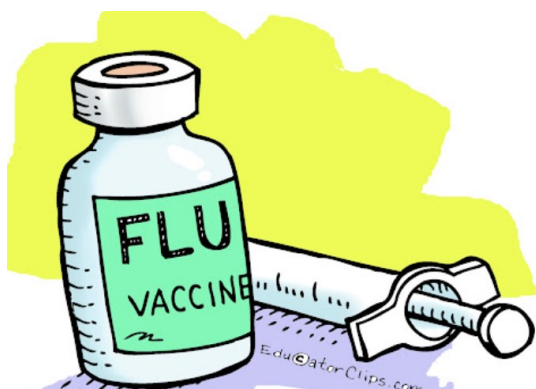

Influenza vaccinations

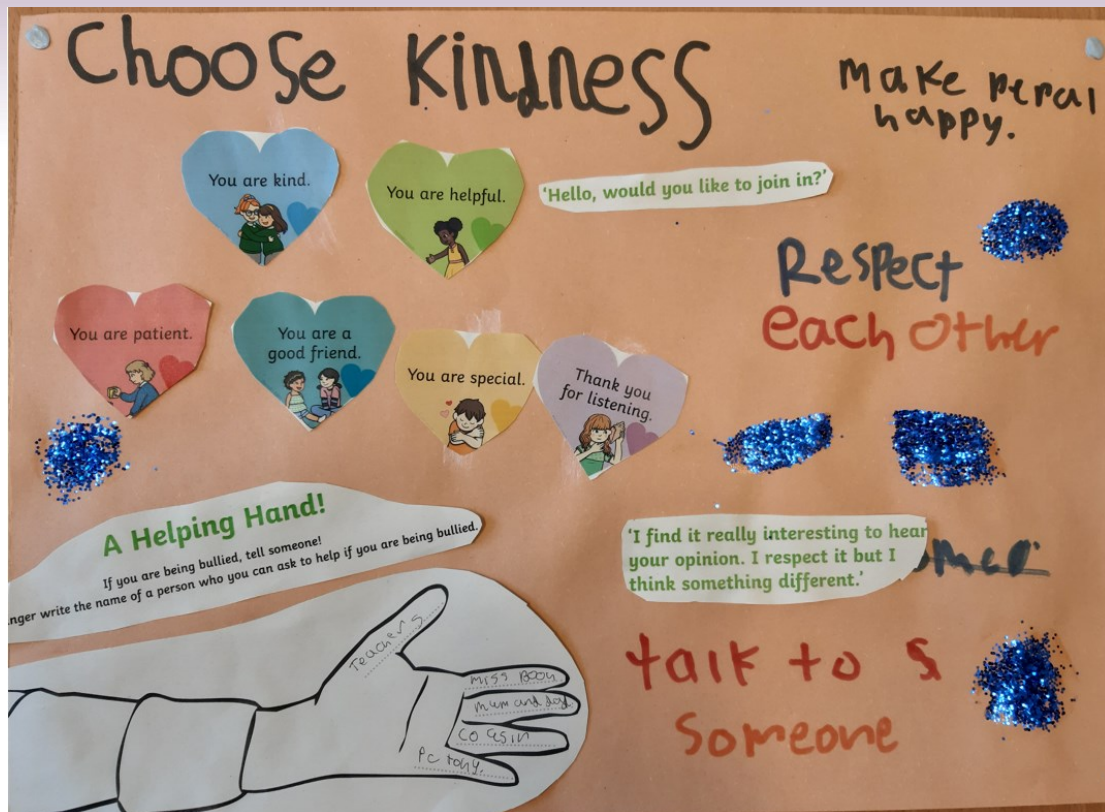
Monday, 13th December
