




Year 10 Art trip to Cartwright Hall


WHAT'S COMING UP NEXT & REMINDERS



NEW SOCIAL TIME ARRANGEMENTS



Well Done BUH!

I'm writing to say "well done" to the overwhelming majority of students who have responded brilliantly to the new dining and break time arrangements this week. It was great to have so many children feedback that they enjoyed a lunchtime where they could sit on a chair and experience a civilised dining environment.

For some time, our most vulnerable students have found the canteen to be a busy and unstructured place. I believe society should be designed around the most vulnerable members of it. With this in mind, I have instructed senior leaders to implement these changes to meet the needs of the most vulnerable in our school community.

Our reasons for making this change to our social time arrangements are, first and fore-most, designed with the safety and welfare of our students and families in mind. We are acutely aware of the risks Covid-19 poses for our extremely vulnerable local community and this new system ensures that the canteen is never over-crowded, and students get plenty of fresh air.

As space is limited in our canteen and we want to give all students the opportunity to sit down to eat, it makes sense to have year group sittings with students taking it in turns to use the canteen.

We know that some parents are concerned that it is too cold for students to be outside. I would like to reassure you that students are only outside for short periods and have a sheltered canopy area to protect them if it rains. I will be writing to you in the New Year with a detailed plan for extreme weather arrangements. This will include silent reading in the hall.

Please ensure your child has a warm winter coat. As a school, we will be buying some for students to wear if you are unable to provide one.
