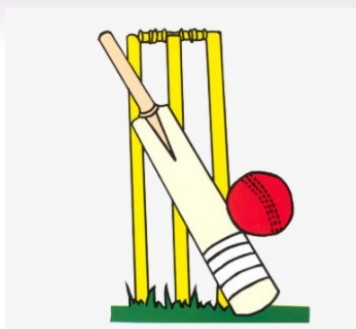
Everything from the script to the lighting and sound has been created and developed by members of this group, for their coursework, and we can't wait to share it!


Students will need to bring their own food and drink and ensure they wear loose, comfortable clothing and trainers.
