"Amazing, brilliant, spectacular, inspiring, mind blowing, spell bounding, impressive, fantastic, outstanding, surprising, superstars".








WHAT'S BEEN HEPPENING IN SCHOOL? THE HISTORY OF INDIA


Year 8 are currently studying the The British Empire and have been learning about the History of India. Students from 8D, F and A have produced these amazing facts sheets.
















YEAR 7 & 8 EASTER SPORTS ACTIVITY DAYS
