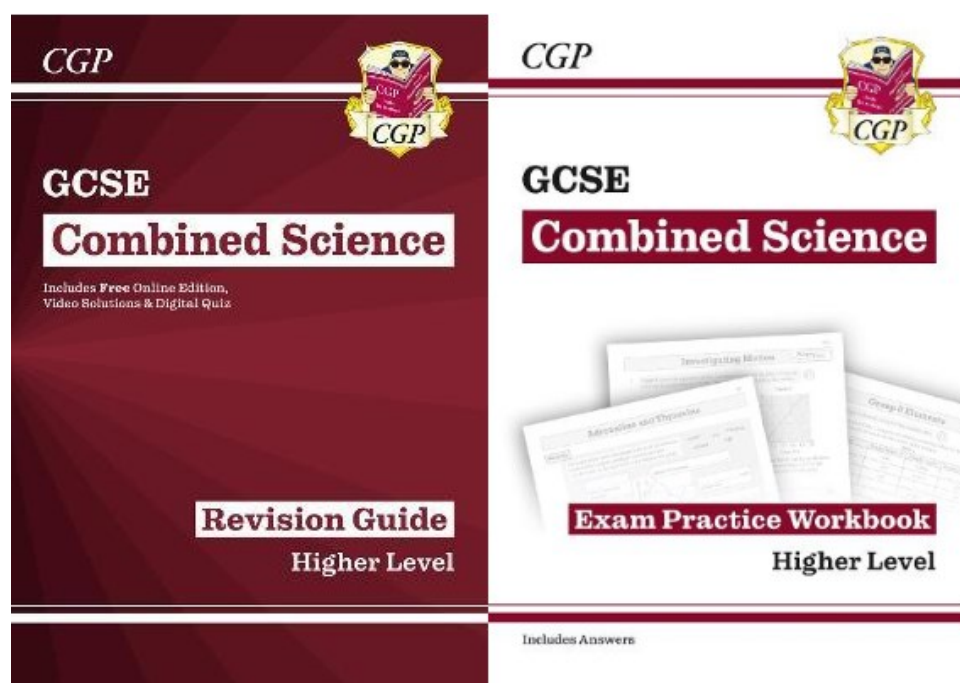

Science Revision Guides
