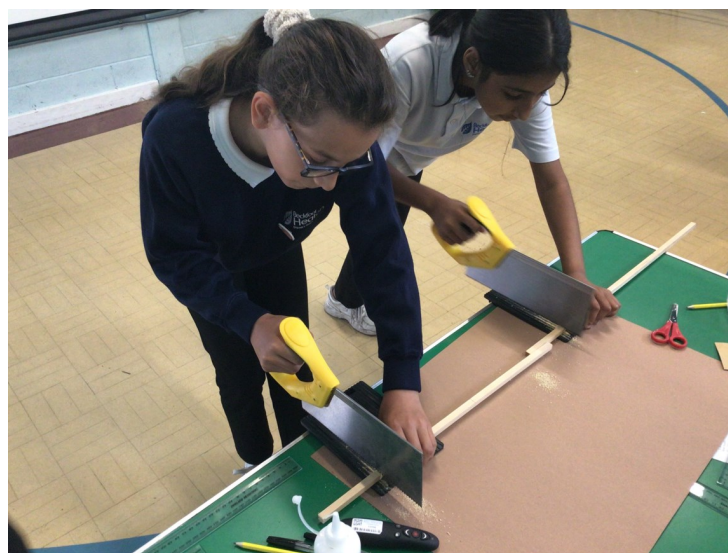
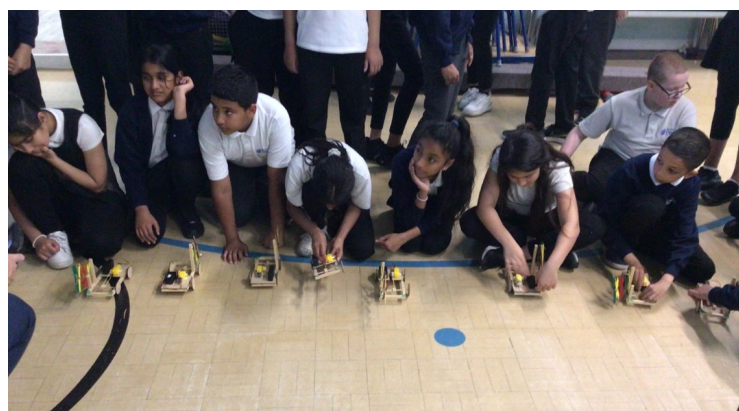


## WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING THIS WEEK?

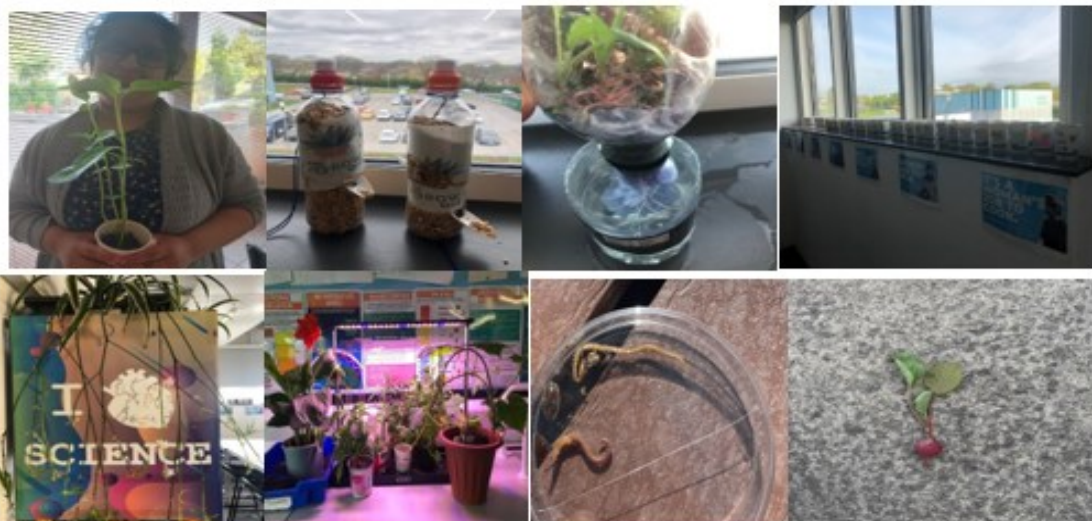
## You Grow Girl - St Ives Trip



On Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> June we took our Eco-STEM Club to St Ives to see nature in action. St Ives Estate is a Country Park located on the outskirts of Bingley. The group showed they are nature lovers, the girls involved walked around some woodland areas, meadows, and Coppice Pond.



The group have been meeting on a Thursday after school and investigating how to grow plants using hydroponics kits, making bird feeders, going on bug hunts, and planting over 100 sunflowers – one for each classroom in school and completing various wildlife challenges. In addition to this the girls have been looking at how they can challenge and smash stereotypes within science.

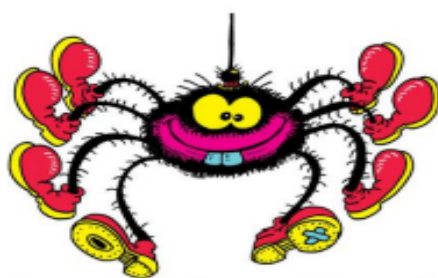

**Anansi  
Spider  
Stories**

Anansi the Spider is a West African (Akan) and West Indian folktale character who is associated with skills and wisdom. However, there is a mischievous side to Anansi, who often outwits foes much larger than themselves.

On the 4-day free Summer Art School, participants are invited to make creative contributions to be incorporated into a collaborative 'Anansi Spider Stories' animation. This animation is part of a research project led by Leeds Arts University Senior Lecturer in Animation Ben Simpson (aka Doctor Simpo) and Film and Photography Instructor Eddie Lockhart. It is intended that the final work will be celebrated and presented in Leeds and beyond in 2023.

Each day, students will work through a series of studio and workshop-based projects. These will be led by inspiring tutors and student ambassadors, who will help develop creative thinking and making skills, such as idea development, experimental drawing, character development, working with 3D materials, printmaking and digital images. Students will be encouraged to explore different careers in the creative industries and will experience what life is like studying at a specialist arts university. It is also an opportunity to find out about studying a creative course in further or higher education.



## WHAT'S HAPPENING ROUND ABOUT?



The Progression Summer Art School is a widening participation initiative that is part of Leeds Arts University's Access and Participation Plan, approved by the Office for Students (OfS). The course is very popular and numbers are limited, therefore applications are considered on an individual basis. Young people from under-represented backgrounds or who live in an area of low participation in higher education will be prioritised.
